Valero: Confident start. Cornets not quite together on quarter rest ups at [A]. Dynamics mixed. Cornets still not all as one! Great percussion and continuity. Emphs and horns on quarter rests.

Carriek: Effective percussion again. Not connected by all the entries in the brass. Balance is good between band and soloist.
[D] Percussion gets into slightly. [E] Tuning a little higher on inner parts. Band and soloist doing well to end.

Two Imps: Great outfits! Good start but ensemble jitters between soloists and also the band. Basses are not square on quarters and there is no sense of pulse! Some jitters a little in the accompaniments I am not sure why?
Some scrappy playing on the refrain, what a shame. Ending is secure and well played.

A Gaelic Blessing Insecure to start, Emphs play well just a little intonation, in Emphs / Baris / Basses. Great Sop playing

Zorro: Back row Cornets, little sharp on your D's but confident and secure playing.
